# **HOW TO APPLY**

Call to schedule an appointment or obtain energy services request for assistance form online.

# **EASCR REQUIREMENTS**

- One or more household members impacted by COVID-19 including, but not limited to, loss of employment, reduction or loss of income, etc.
- · Household must meet income guidelines.
- Provide current (previous 30 days) documentation of gross income OR proof of enrollment in any of the following programs: WIC, TANF, SNAP, SSI, Medicaid, OHP, LIHEAP or OEAP.

# LIHEAP REQUIREMENTS

- Be a resident of Marion or Polk County.
- Applicant must live in the household.
- Account holder must live in the household.
- · Household must meet income guidelines.
- · Current electric bill.
- Proof of income for the last 30 days.
- Social Security cards for all household members (if applicable).
- Proof of identity (Driver's License, State ID, Military ID, etc.).

#### **INCOME GUIDELINES**

EASCR Income Guideline (80% of Area Median Income by Household Size)

LIHEAP Income Guideline 2019–2020 (60% of OR Median Income by Household Size)

A copy of your Social Security card can be ordered online by setting up an online account at https://ssa.gov and requesting the card. (Note: You must be 18, not requesting a name change and have a driver's license or state-issued ID.)
